CALENDAR OVERVIEW 2019-2020 SCHOOL YEAR

PA requires a minimum of 180 documented days of school for each student.

SSCA plans to hold 143 days of academic instruction for students.

Parents are responsible for 37 additional days of instruction.

IF YOUR CHILD IS ABSENT FROM SCHOOL FOR ANY REASON, IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PARENT TO COMPLETE AN ADDITIONAL DAY OF INSTRUCTION TO ENSURE YOU REACH THE REQUIRED 180.

SSCA will follow the Quaker Valley and Noah's Ark schedule for weather delays and cancellations. Depending on how many days we miss due to inclement weather, we will schedule make-up days. We will be sure to communicate clearly and frequently about these days as the winter months unfold.

We recommend using the attached chart to document home education days. Simply mark each square with the date each time you complete a school day with your child. Please note the first box contains 40 days, assuming your child misses three days throughout the year. The second chart is to keep track of any additional days you need to complete due to illness, absence, or weather cancellations. Teachers will review attendance history with parents throughout the year to ensure our records coincide with parents.

Music and Physical Education Requirements:

Because music and P.E. are not core academic areas, SSCA will not be teaching these subjects. By MAY 1, 2020 please provide your student's teacher with:

- a. Two documents which indicate your student's participation in music
- b. Two documents which indicate your student's participation in P.E.

Possible examples:

Music:

- A picture of your student attending the symphony or other professional musical performance
- A picture of your student during a weekly piano lesson
- Copies of music your child played on an instrument at the beginning then end of the year to show progress
- A list of music your child has listened to and read about to grow their appreciation of music
- A picture of your student and a musical instrument they created on their own

Physical Education:

- A picture of your child's baseball, soccer, lacrosse, etc. team
- A picture of your child learning to ice skate, ski, shoot a basketball etc.
- A list of books about hygiene or health your child has read with you
- A short description of a visit your child made to a doctor or dentist to learn about health
- Record of your child's participation in anything physically active

We will provide reminders of our need for these documents throughout the year, but thank you in advance for your partnership and involvement in your child's education.



Payment Schedule for St. Stephen's Classical Academy Tuition 2019-2020

All tuition payments are due on the 15th of each month August-May. Please make checks payable to St. Stephen's Church with St. Stephen's Classical Academy and your child's name on the memo line. Please drop tuition payments in the appropriate folder on the SSCA bulletin board at dismissal.

There are three options for tuition payments. When determining your monthly payment please keep in mind:

- If you paid a \$400 tuition deposit with your application, your remaining tuition is \$3,600 and your monthly payment will be \$360.
- If you paid a \$100 tuition deposit with your application, your remaining tuition is \$3,900 and your monthly payment will be \$390.
- If you received a scholarship, please adjust your monthly payment to reflect the reduced tuition.

SNACK GUIDELINES

Because students will not be eating lunch at SSCA, we will have a designated snack time each day. Please pack your child a snack each day and be mindful of a few guidelines:

- 1. WE ARE A NUT FREE FACILITY. Due to severe allergies in several classrooms, please be sure your student does not bring anything containing nuts of any kind.
- 2. Snack time will last 10-15 minutes each day, so please pack something your child can enjoy in the allotted time.
- 3. Your child should bring a water bottle with them every day. This will be used during snack time, and reduces trips to the water fountain throughout the day. Water only please!
- 4. We are happy to celebrate your child's birthday during snack time. If you would like to provide a snack for the entire class at any time throughout the year, please arrange this with your child's teacher before sending the treat.



Uniform Order Information

SSCA will be working with Lands' End as the provider of school uniforms. Please visit www.landsend.com/ and choose the 'SCHOOL' tab. There will be a button on this page 'FIND YOUR SCHOOL.' Once you search for St. Stephen's Classical Academy, our uniform choices will be made available to you. Lands' End will be running various promotions throughout the summer and they will embroider our logo on your items.

If you wish to purchase your child's uniform from a different store, feel free to do so. If you purchase uniform items from Wal-Mart, Target, Old Navy, etc., please be sure they are clothing items intended to be used as a school uniform. The guidelines are:

- Plain navy blue or white collared polo shirt
- Khaki shorts or pants (uniform style, no cargo shorts/pants)
- Navy blue or khaki jumper for girls
- Close toed shoes

We love seeing our students come to school looking like a team and ready to learn! **Please** put your child's initials on the tags of all clothing items to avoid any confusion.

SUPPLY LISTS

*We would really appreciate the inclusion of a box or package of top-loading sheet protectors with your child's supplies. We use these throughout the year to compile portfolios.
